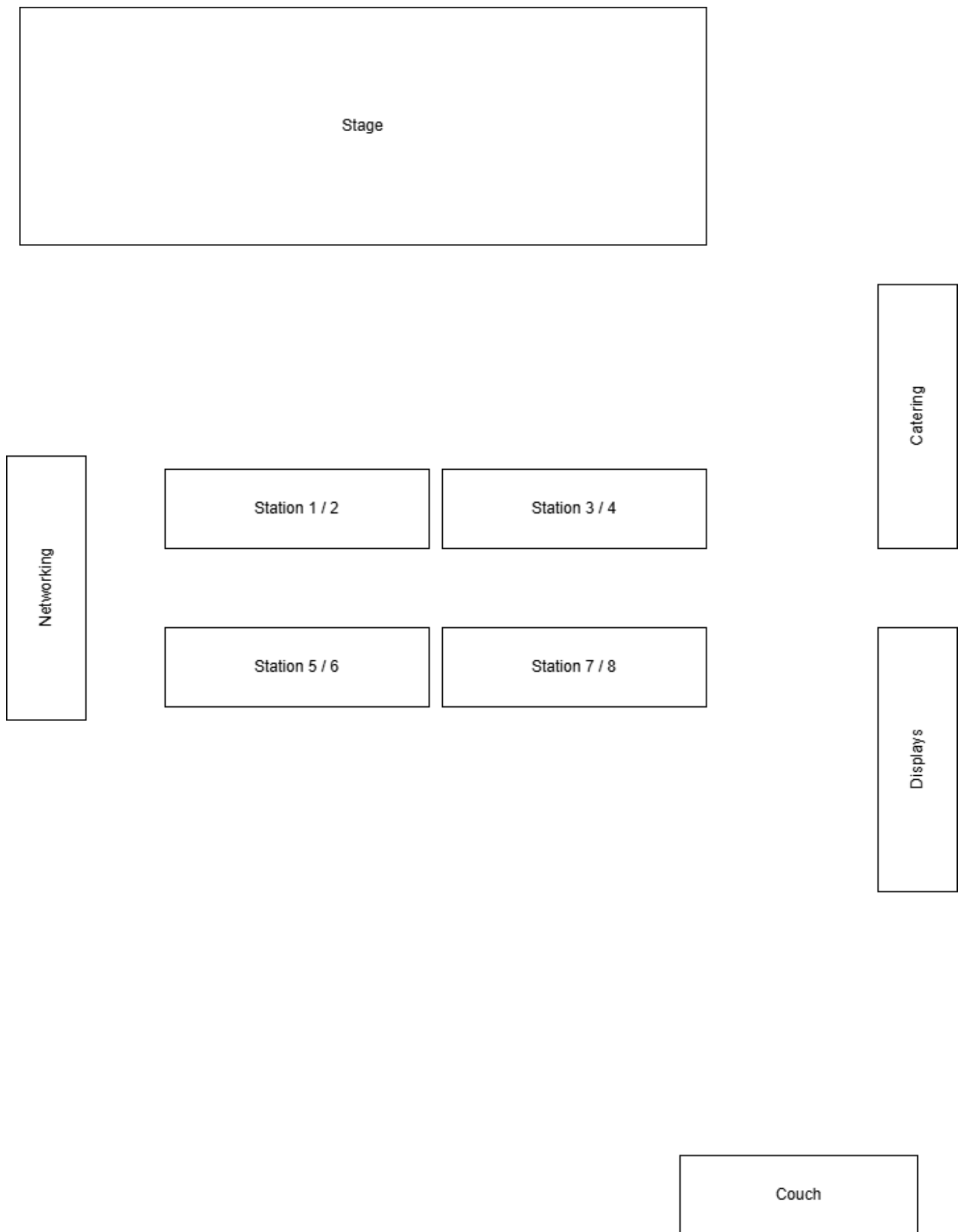
To make the most of your LAN party experience, participants are required to bring:
